- Students **must** be at least **16+ years**.
- Students **must** have a minimum level of **B1 oral English**.
- We will do our best to match a request for a particular type of placement, however **IELA** reserve the right to assign a placement to each student as available.
- Once a placement has been agreed and assigned by **IELA**, students cannot decide to change.
- Students must attend the work placement at the times specified.
- If a student decides they do not like the placement **IELA** cannot offer an alternative placement.
- If a student decides not to attend their work placement, **IELA** reserve the right to terminate the placement and programme.
- If a student cannot attend their work placement because of illness, they must notify **IELA** as soon as possible.
- If a student decides they want to terminate the placement early **IELA** cannot refund fees.
- **IELA** & the employer reserves the right to terminate the placement if necessitated.

Please note: Customer facing businesses can have quiet days as well as very busy days. This is real life. **IELA** cannot change a placement if a student finds it too quiet or too busy.
