- Students must be at least 16+ years.
- Students <u>must</u> have a minimum level of **B1 Oral English**.
- We will do our best to match a request for a particular type of placement, however IELA reserve the right to assign a placement to each student as available.
- > Once a placement has been agreed and assigned by IELA, students cannot decide to change.
- > Students must attend the work placement at the times specified.
- > If a student decides they do not like the placement IELA cannot offer an alternative placement.
- > If a student decides not to attend their work placement, IELA reserve the right to terminate the placement and programme.
- > If a student cannot attend their work placement because of illness, they must notify IELA as soon as possible.
- > If a student decides they want to terminate the placement early IELA cannot refund fees.
- > IELA & the Employer reserves the right to terminate the placement.
